

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today's feast of the Holy Trinity invites us to reflect the divine mystery. The doctrine of the Trinity was the result of the reflection by Christians, in the time after the New Testament was written, on their experience of God as revealed in Christ's life, death and resurrection. This is a relationship we can only begin to understand by entering into it with faith, hope and love. The doctrine of the Trinity is not, then, an abstruse theological puzzle but comes from a sense of being grasped by and held within a divine communion of love. Today's readings communicate a very dynamic sense of life in relationship to the outgoing divine communion of love that is the Trinity.

There are a surprising number of places with a Trinitarian pattern in the Letters of Paul. Today's Second Reading (Rom 8:14-17) is one of these. The Spirit communicates to believers a sense of the intimacy with God the Father. Through Christ we are sons and daughters of God. Jesus addressed God as 'Abba' (= 'Dad'). Even when the early Christians moved into Greek-speaking milieus, they retained the original Aramaic word. They found that the Spirit was impelling them to address God in the same terms (Rom 8:15; Gal 4:6) – this indicates that we share the intimacy and closeness of Jesus' relationship to the Father. This delivers us from a fearful relationship with God to one of confidence, freedom and love. We are 'one of the God's family'. Being God's sons and daughters leads us being heirs to eternal life. Sharing Christ's sufferings we share his glory.

Today's Gospel (Matt 28:16-20) is explicitly trinitarian: at the end of Gospel is the commission to baptise 'in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit'. The risen Lord empowers the Church to go into the whole world to 'make disciples' by communicating to people a sense of the divine love and the conquest of sin and death brought about by Christ. When people who respond to the proclamation of the Gospel receive baptism in the name of the Trinity they become members of a people liberated from slavery to enjoy the privileged closeness to God described in the First Reading, immensely deepened through the intimacy gained in Christ. We give concrete expression to this relationship in our lives by attitudes, words and actions. —*Blessings, Greg*
