Easter Confession
— 2nd Rite of Reconciliation
THIS Wednesday 6 April
at 7pm

Join us for an hour for this quietly reflective celebration of healing and reconciliation as part of your Lenten preparations for Easter. The word of God will be proclaimed 3 times as in Lectio Divina. In the quiet, allow His words to speak to you. The priests will be in full view of all present. Your confession is to be kept brief and you return to your seat for prayer—**don't go home yet!** Stay to give thanks together as a community as we rejoice in our renewed friendship and new life with God.

Please note: This is a communal rite and confession is to be kept brief, allowing all present the time to access the sacrament. If you feel you will need more time with the priest, please attend the 1st Rite of Reconciliation held on Saturdays 10am - 11am or 5pm - 5.30pm.

Celebrating COVID Safe Easter and WA Government Level 1 measures



◆ In line with the current COVID restrictions, seating **INSIDE** our church is limited to **366 people per Mass** (2 sqm rule applied).



◆ Mask wearing is required for people aged 8 years and above.

If you intend to come to ANY of the Masses, especially at Easter, and wish to be inside, please come a bit earlier.

Once the capacity is reached, the glass doors will all be opened, and you are welcome to stay outdoor. Please bring your own chairs or a picnic rug and sit on the grass. Our sound system will ensure you will be able to hear clearly. Holy Communion will also be distributed outside the church.



◆ 1st and 2nd collections will recommence as of this weekend while contact registering will no longer be required.

Due to ease of transmission of the Omicron virus please continue observing the following measures:

- ◆ Sanitise your hands as you enter church or parish centre.
- ◆ Keep a safe physical distance between people of different households.
- ◆ If feeling unwell, or have flu-like symptoms or fever or have been in contact with a person/s suspected to have or who have been diagnosed with COVID 19, do not attend church/parish centre.
