Dear brothers and sisters,

Today's Gospel (Lk 10:25-37) presents us with a parable which sums up so much of the teaching of Jesus. Jesus is confronted by a hostile lawyer who first asks him a trick question: 'What must I do to inherit eternal life?' Jesus answers this challenge with a challenge of his own by asking 'what is written in the Law?' The lawyer responds correctly by quoting the need to love God and neighbour. So, the lawyer already had the answer to his own question and is shown up. To justify himself he asks another trick question, 'Who is my neighbour?'

Jesus answers by telling the story of a man beaten up, robbed and left for dead beside a busy road. Two representative religious Jews walk past and because of the holiness laws of ritual purity they don't stop or render assistance. Touching blood or a dead body would make them unclean and unable to pray in their sacred duties. The third traveller is not another Jew but one of their hated enemies. Jews held Samaritan in contempt. They were bad in every way. Against all expectation the Samaritan is 'moved (to the guts) with compassion'. He doesn't just administer first aid but is generous in paying for long term care of the victim. The ethnic enemy is a truly admirable human being.

Jesus then asks the lawyer who was neighbour to the victim. Once more he answers correctly- "the one who showed compassion". Telling the story today we might replace the Samaritan with a good atheist, a good Muslim, or a good bikie rather than someone who is a saint, or who looks like us or who shares our theological and political opinions. The Samaritan does not see a Jew but simply a person in need of help. So, our neighbour is anyone who is in need. Crucially, we are challenged to be neighbour to the needy whoever they may be. Who is not our neighbour? Who do we hold in contempt?

The 'way to eternal life' is to allow oneself to become an active instrument of the boundary-breaking hospitality of God. The First Reading (Deut 30:10-14) lines up with the Gospel in that we do not have to go far to fulfil what God wants. The 'word is very near' to us, it is 'in my mouth, in my heart'. The way to eternal life begins right here and now with those around us.—*Blessings, Greg*
