Dear sisters and brothers,

The prayer for today's mass for the 10th Sunday of the Year is: "O God, from whom all good things come, grant that we, who call on you in our need, may at your prompting discern what is right, and by your guidance do it". All good things, and only good things, come from God, so too what is upright come forth from us when we both think and do what is upright. So, we pray for a union of mind and heart in the Spirit. In our relationship with God, we can discern what the Spirit is asking of us in every situation and allow God's grace to shape all our relationships and actions. In this way we participate in God's creative and salvific work. God continues to inspire people in our fallen world.

In today's Marcan Gospel we have an account of a complex episode in Jesus' ministry. His ministry is set within two sources of misunderstanding: one from his family, the other and from the scribes who are his chief critics. The family of Jesus think he is out of his mind because he is entering into the oppressive world of evil spirits- the sort of behaviour that today we understand as stemming from psychiatric issues rather than ancient world's understanding as demonic possession. Jesus liberates people from their afflictions rather than himself being tarnished or overwhelmed by them. Jesus is stronger than the spirits, the powers of the world or whatever afflicts suffering human persons. It is by the Holy Spirit, the very power of God, that he 'expels demons'. To question this is the doubt God's goodness and action in the world.

What is remarkable is that Jesus tells us 'all ... sins will be forgiven.' . Jesus has come to offer the universal forgiveness associated with the onset of the Kingdom (1:15; 2:5). I think we need to take this to heart. It is not helpful to wallow in guilt or shame rather than rejoicing in God's mercy and compassion that sines forth in his forgiveness of all sins. Sin is real but in God's mercy all shall be well. God's first and last word to is us love and forgiveness not judgment.




