

Dear sisters and brothers,

The Collect: O God, who show the light of your truth to those who go astray, so that they may return to the right path, give all who for the faith they profess are accounted Christians the grace to reject whatever is contrary to the name of Christ and to strive after all that does it honour. This prayer was written by Pope Gelasius I (592-596). It was part of his campaign against Christian participation in the pagan festival of Lupercalia. In our present context it is interesting that it has an ecumenical angle. We pray that all who profess to be Christian receive the grace to reject what is contrary to the grace of Christ and live in the light of love and truth.

At Baptism immediately after water is poured or we are immersed in the water the celebrant prays: ***God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed you from sin, given you a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and welcomed you into his holy people. He now anoints you with the chrism of salvation. As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so may you live always as a member of his body, sharing everlasting life.*** Through Baptism we share the priestly, royal and prophetic mission of Jesus. Our readings today centre on the mission of a prophet.

The **First Reading** (Amos 7:12-15) tells of the prophet Amos' rejection at Bethel. Amos was a southerner from Judah given the task of being a prophet to the northern kingdom of Israel. Amos criticised the worship there because it legitimated social inequality and the exploitation of the poor. Amos is not a professional prophet but a simple shepherd. He was surprisingly called to be a prophet to deliver the Lord's judgment not his own.

The **Gospel** (Mk 6:7-13) places the Twelve in the line of this authentic prophetic tradition. They are ordinary people sent out with the authority of Jesus to carry his liberating word and continue his healing ministry. They are to travel light, depending entirely on the hospitality of strangers. Theirs is the prophetic vocation of joyfully proclaiming the Good News and forming Christian communities.

The prophetic mission of the Twelve inaugurates the mission of the Church. It establishes a community that through the preaching of the word and celebration of the sacraments continues the mission of Jesus to set people free, bringing them healing and communion with God and others. The **Second Reading** (Eph 1:3-14) unfolds God's amazing design to reconcile Jews, Gentiles and all people in the communion of the Church. We are called to give up rivalry to live as reconciled people rejoicing in the praise of God's glory.

Monday 15 July - Communion Service in place of 9:00am Mass

The Carmelite friars will be attending an important meeting on Monday morning, 15 July. Therefore, we are not available for mass at 9.00am. There will be a communion service in its place.

Next week is Sea Sunday when the church prays for all those who live and work at sea. Stella Maris is the official maritime welfare agency of the Catholic Church. Any changes would involve refunds and fresh payments to be made. Mass bookings via Eventbrite is live on Monday 15th July 9.30am and will close on Monday 22nd July.
