Dear sisters and brothers,

The Collect: Draw near to your servants, O Lord, and answer their prayers with unceasing kindness, that, for those who glory in you as their Creator and guide, you may restore what you have created, and keep safe what you have restored. This is another ancient prayer from the time when Rome was recovering from a barbarian siege in 537. Uppermost in the intention of the prayer is that God restore and preserve our peace and security after loss, stress or trauma.

Today our **Gospel** reading is from John (6: 24 -35), where we begin the long discourse on the Bread of Life. The **First Reading** (Ex 16:2-4, 12-15) describes the gift of 'bread from heaven' with which God fed the Israelites lost in the desert. As the Passover is central to the Jewish religious identity this is good background to Jesus speaking of himself as the Bread of Life.

The crowds who Jesus had fed by multiplying loaves and fish catch up with him and engage him in conversation. They ask questions that show they misunderstand who he is and what is his mission. Part of this is their sense of identity is closed and are not open to anything new. Jesus points out that they have been seeking him because they had been fed. They failed to 'see the sign', that is the meaning of feeding the five thousands.

The multiplied bread and fish is a sign pointing to Jesus himself. He is the 'Bread' sent from heaven to satisfy the deepest human needs. All that is needed is to believe in Jesus, the Bread of Life. The people are unconvinced and talk about Moses as the miracle worker in the desert. Jesus says No! it was God not Moses who fed them and set them free. Now God has sent Jesus as the Bread from heaven for the life of the world. People need to let go their accustomed certainties to be open to receive the lasting gift of God in Jesus.

Through the spiritual nourishment of the Bread of Life, we live our Christian vocation in the particular calling/vocation that God has given each of us so that we will never be hungry or thirsty again and can bring nourishment to those around us. Vatican II stated in the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy that Christ, the Bread of Life, is truly present in the person of the priest, the Word of God, the consecrated bread and wine, and in the Church community gathered in prayer. We live out our personal vocation that is God-centred, fed by full, conscious and active participation in the Eucharist, and redemptive for ourselves and for those with whom we share life in the world.

#### A Suggestion

I recently saw the Australian movie The Way, My Way and found it funny, stunningly beautiful and thoughtful. It is about a very unlikely pilgrim from Australia on the ancient Camino de Santiago de Compostela. The Camino, "the Way", is an 800 km pilgrimage to the Shrine of St James in Santiago. The movie will be showing at the Event Cinema, Morley on Friday, 23 August at 10.30AM You may enjoy it!




