Dear sisters and brothers,

Served by Teresian Carmelite Friars

Today's Collect: O God, by whom we are redeemed and receive adoption, look graciously upon your beloved sons and daughters, that those who believe in Christ may receive true freedom and an everlasting inheritance. Today's prayer summarises Paul's understanding in the Letter to the Galatians of our salvation in Christ. We are God's beloved adopted children. May God bring us to the fullness of life in Christ and the Spirit, free from all sin and death.

The healing miracle of a deaf person in today's **Gospel,** (Mk 6:31-37) links us to our **First Reading** (Is 35:4-7) which describes the blessings of the messianic age. Jesus fulfils this hope. Out of sensitivity for wounded humanity Jesus performs the acts of healing expected of the Messiah privately. He does not want the crowds to conclude that he is a royal or political Messiah. His full identity will only be revealed on the cross. He came 'not to be served but to serve and give his life as a ransom for many' (10:45).

Jesus has come that all people may hear the word of life and come to transforming faith. May our ears be opened, and our tongues 'loosened' for our full participation in the community of faith. In our **Second Reading** (Jas 2: 1-5) James reminds us, there can't be special treatment and honour for those who are privileged. This links to Jesus' own words recorded in the Gospels and his mission to the poor and suffering of his time.

Safeguarding Sunday

Today, therefore, is a good time to reaffirm our commitment to creating a church that embodies trust, safety, inclusion, and respect for everyone, particularly our children and vulnerable adults. It is also a time to pray for those who have been abused. Perth Archdiocese acknowledges the lifelong trauma of abuse victims, survivors and their families, and continues to pray for their healing. We are committed to fostering a culture of safety and care for all children and adults.

The theme for National Child Protection Week 2024 is "Every child, in every community, needs a fair go" and "Every conversation matters". Conversations are powerful tools for keeping children and young people safe and well. Conversations can help us understand issues, craft solutions, value community knowledge, and social connections of children and young people.

We recognise and thank all those involved in safeguarding work in our parish, especially our safeguarding officers. Your dedication to making our church a safe and nurturing place is deeply appreciated. Children's activity booklets and colouring pages are available in the entrance to the church. It is best to complete them with your children or grandchildren.
