God bless you and all your family

Dear sisters and brothers,

Collect: O God, who founded all the commands of your sacred Law upon love of you and of our neighbour, grant that, by keeping your precepts, we may merit to attain eternal life. Our prayer today is modern. It joins two sixth century prayers- one from Rome and one from Spain. It is based on Jesus' great commandment to love God and neighbour. Living out the prayer is a grace for each of us but also in the peace and harmony of the whole church in its life and worship which ends in the joy of eternal life.

In today's **Gospel** (Mk 9:30-37) we find Jesus back on the road to Jerusalem preparing the disciples for his rejection, suffering and death. Notwithstanding this, the disciples argue about who of them will get what positions of power and prestige in the kingdom (Mk 9:30-37). Coincidentally, in our **Second Reading** (Jas 3:16-4:3) James forthrightly condemns just such envy, rivalry and competition.

Jesus portrays his own ministry and mission in terms of service and humility rather than privilege and power. He came as the humblest servant of all and not a lord to be served. He tells them to do as he does and to welcome those without any status as friends and equals. Children at the time of Jesus, while loved by their families, were of no status or importance. The followers of Jesus are to put aside their social status and self-importance and to be as children are. This is not a call to be childish but to a warm and humble hospitality that values each and every human

In the 4th century, after Constantine, the Christian community received many privileges from the Empire and church leaders began to take on the trappings of Imperial officials. This led to an alliance of Church and State which we call Christendom. That union has, since the French Revolution, had its day. We are called back to the simplicity and depth of Jesus' own life as the model for us personally and for the leaders of the Church of today and into the future. In the spirit of today's readings let us pray for the Synod on Synodality in Rome throughout October.




LITTLE SISTERS OF THE POOR APPEAL Next weekend 28th and 29th September at all Masses
