Dear sisters and brothers,

Collect: *Grant us, we pray, O Lord our God, the constant gladness of being devoted to you, for it is full and lasting happiness to serve with constancy the author of all that is good.* Coming to the end of the Church's year our theme this week is the end of things. Today's collect prayer is another written by Pope Vigilius in 537 when Rome was besieged by the Ostrogoths. Things were grim. Rome had just been through famine and pestilence when the news that Imperial troops were coming to relieve the city. The prayer asks that God may grace the Church in its trials with a joy which comes from the service of God which guarantees full and unending happiness. Since we now live in Christ, even in the times of crisis and difficulty, we always have reason to rejoice.

Our **First Reading** is from the Book of Daniel (Dan 12:1-3) which was written in a time of great crisis. It is not history by an apocalypse. Its aim is to encourage people in difficult times by assuring them of the final victory. The context is that Antiochus Epiphanes IV of the Seleucid Empire wanted to modernise and civilise the Jewish people by replacing their religion, turning the Temple into a gymnasium etc. Many faithful people suffered and died in this persecution and war. Daniel tells his readers not to despair for God will intervene through Michael to defend them. The moral is do not lose heart. Even if you die you will be vindicated in the life after death.

Our **Gospel** (Mk 13: 24-32) is similarly apocalyptic. Jesus foresees the destruction of the Temple and the city of Jerusalem with wars and turmoil on an international scale, the persecution of his followers and even betrayal within the community. Many will be tempted to despair. Jesus understands these feelings and responds with a message of hope: The Son of Man will come, but we won't know the timing. Do not lose heart, remain faithful. What is important is not a feeling, but that we are ready to welcome the Lord, whenever and however he comes. The Gospel addresses our present uncertain world situation and the dismay and despondency many now experience.

Jesus who was crucified and seemingly overcome by evil, now extends his resurrection to the entire universe. The **Second Reading** (Heb 10:11-14, 18) tells us that Christ, his work as High Priest concluded once and for all upon the cross, now sits in triumph at God's right hand, until the full effects of redemption are worked out in the universe.

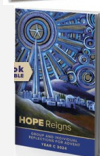
