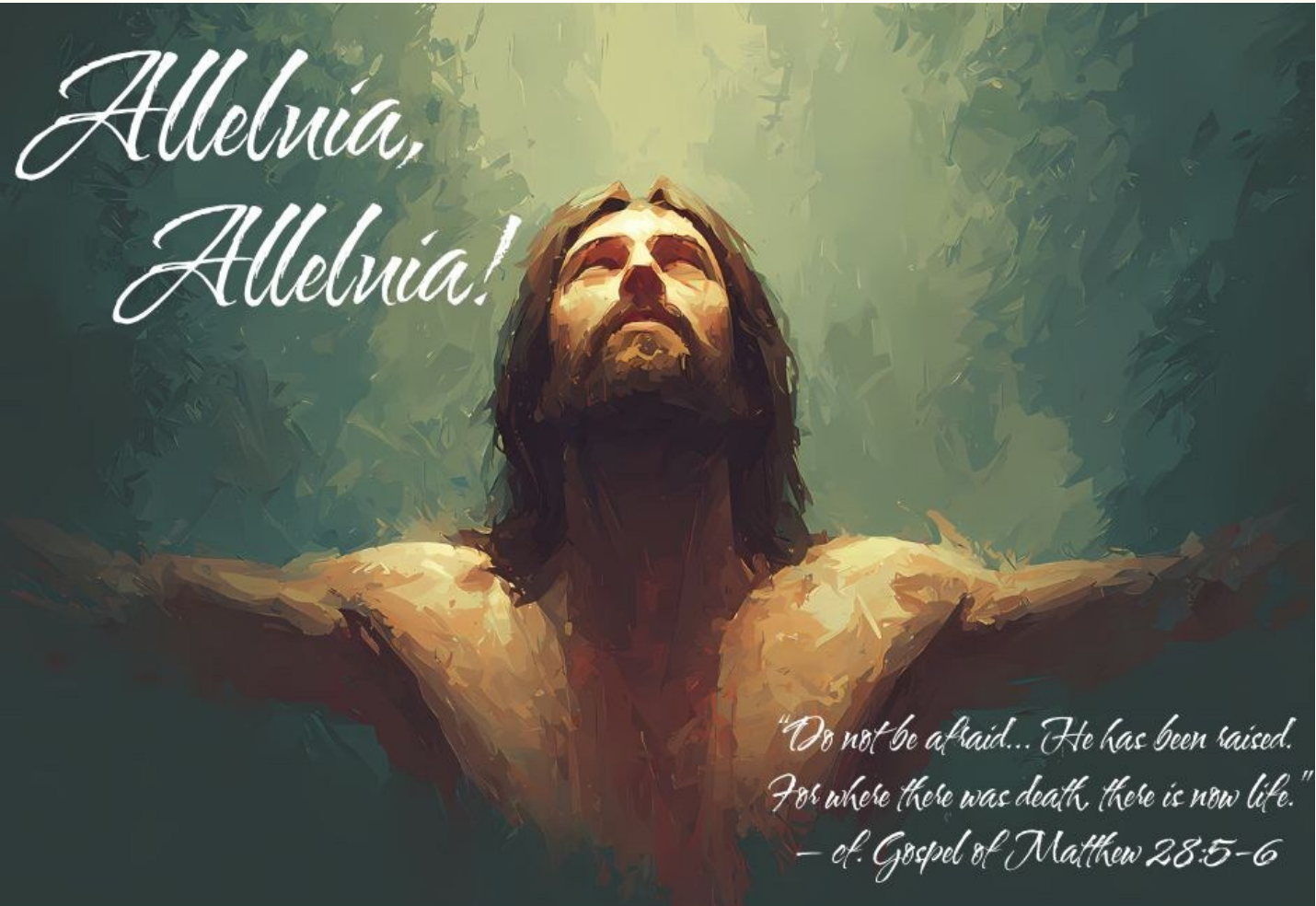


Alleluia, Alleluia!



*"Do not be afraid... He has been raised.
For where there was death, there is now life."
— cf. Gospel of Matthew 28:5-6*

*Darkness, Light.
Sin, Grace.
Evil, Goodness.
Death, Life.*

In a world that seems to get darker each passing day, where is the light (cf. Is 9:2)? In a world where sin abounds, are we to believe that grace abounds more (cf. Rom 5:20)? In a world that prides itself on committing grave evil, is there goodness left (cf. Gal 5:19-23)? In a world where death has touched whole hordes of people, is it true that death has, in fact, lost its sting (cf. 1 Cor 15:55)? What, therefore, are we to make of our Christian faith?

Without the eyes of faith, it is easy to lose hope and so give up on love. However, in witnessing the death of Jesus, the Disciples showed that even with faith, hope can be lost and love abandoned. And yet it is this same faith that reminds us that something remarkable did happen three days later!

Though not witnessed directly, the radiance of the Resurrection resonated so deep in the hearts of those restless Apostles that they were forever changed. The Resurrection of Jesus so emboldened their faith that they who were once timid, flawed and heedless became empowered to boldly proclaim the Gospel of Hope as they poured out love even to the point of death. Through the Apostles, the Church grew from a band of followers in some remote Roman colony to become a global movement establishing hospitals, schools, universities and other charitable organisations across countless generations. Christ's Resurrection has certainly changed the world! Yet, how are we to reconcile *our* continued experience of darkness, sin, evil, and death?

The Resurrection of Jesus has inaugurated the re-creation of the world: *now* is the time of God's favour, *now* is the day of salvation (cf. 2 Cor 6:2). However, each and every one of us are called to walk in the light, be transformed by grace, and so live in goodness. The experience of darkness, sin, evil, and death, firstly in ourselves, provides us with the very opportunity of allowing the glory of the Resurrection to personally give us God's light, grace, goodness, and life. And insofar as we are transformed, so we then allow God to transfigure the world through our lives. The mystery of Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection must be lived out in our lives if we are to participate in bringing about the Kingdom of God.

The essence of the Easter message is one grounded in a firm hope that no darkness can ever overcome the Light of God; no sin is ever greater than grace, no evil more overpowering than the goodness of love, and that death has indeed yielded its power to the Lord of Life!

May you all, therefore, experience the profound, transforming grace of Easter deep in your soul that you may remain steadfast in hope and learn to love graciously, gracefully, and generously now and always. Have a blessed and grace-filled Easter.

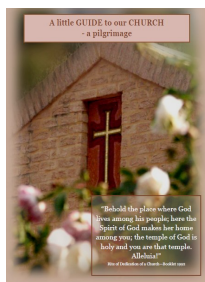
kind donations of non-perishable food, placed in the Vinnies box, on the left side of the lobby as you go out the church.
