Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate Trinity Sunday – the highest mystery of the Christian Faith – it is worth taking time to consider an essential aspect of our Faith. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

“[T]he Christian faith is not a ‘religion of the book.’ Christianity is the religion of the ‘Word’ of God, a word which is ‘not a written and mute word, but the Word which is incarnate and living’” (CCC 108).

The Word of God is Jesus, who - *alive and active* – has promised to be with us always to the end of time (cf. Mt 28:20). Our faith is a faith of Divine Revelation in the Person of Jesus made accessible by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The point is, God who is utterly transcendent would otherwise be unfathomable to the human mind if He did not first *reveal* Himself. Whilst human reasoning and philosophy alone could come to the conclusion that there has to be a God who intelligently designed the world, this human faculty and endeavour could never uncover God to actually be Triune. God had to simply reveal this truth about Himself.

It was through the Church’s prayers, reflections, and a living relationship with Jesus *in* the Spirit that allowed Her to discern the nature of God. Specifically, it was in taking the claims of Jesus seriously that, through a process spanning many centuries, gradually uncovered the truth of God enshrined in the Creed.

Because the Catholic Faith is not a religion of the book, it cannot be reduced to the Bible alone (*sola Scriptura*). Catholics believe that the Church has been given the power by God Himself to definitively interpret the meaning of Scripture. These interpretations form the Living Tradition (note, capital ‘t’ of the Church. Therefore, our Catholic Faith insists that the fullness of Revelation has two sources – Scripture and Tradition – safeguarded by the Magisterium.

Case in point, if we take the doctrine of the Trinity, nowhere in Scripture do we find the word “trinity”. And yet, a closer reflection and examination of the whole of Scripture, firstly reveals the *union and distinction* of the Son and the Father (cf. John 14-17). That’s two Persons accounted for! Furthermore, in various passages, the Holy Spirit is ascribed “personal” characteristics. Once again, through a series of prayerful reflection, theological and philosophical debates, the Church ruled that the Holy Spirit had to be God in order to fulfill His function of revealing the truth of Jesus (cf. John 3:6-8; 6:63; 14:16-17, etc.). This accounts for the third Person in the Trinity.

An important passage that helps us see the truth of the Trinity is Mt 28:19. There, Jesus’ commands us to baptise the nations in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Importantly, Jesus does not say “names” (plural) but “name” (singular) attesting to the unity of the three Persons. This is significant because it is precisely in being baptised in God (and no other) that we attain our ultimate goal: salvation of soul.

The topic of the Trinity is as complex as it is central; much too complex for a Sunday bulletin piece. However, it is of utmost importance to our understanding of God, from which flows our understanding of ourselves, our mission, morality, and our end. In all things, I invite you to pray to God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, that you may be filled with grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit now and always.

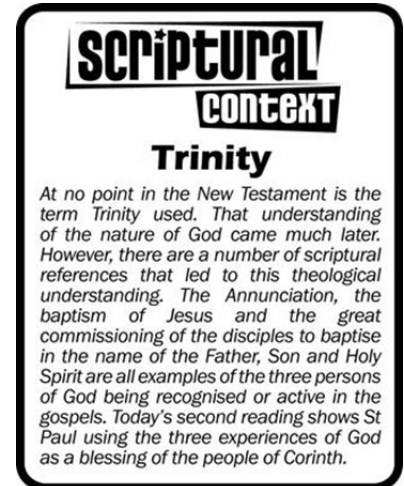
